The Tsechu is one of the best ways to experience the ancient living culture of Bhutan. Also visit sacred sites in Paro, Thimphu, Punakha and view the **Black-Necked Cranes** in the beautiful **Phobjikha Valley**. There is also an optional day tour of the beautiful Haa Valley available as part of this tour.

 Jokhang in Lhasa.
